


# **CCBHC Grant Update**

In September 2022, Lapeer County Community Mental Health (LCCMH) was awarded a four-year Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) Planning, Development, and Implementation Grant through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). The purpose of a CCBHC is to ensure access to coordinated, comprehensive behavioral health care by prioritizing evidence-based services, quick access to treatment, and care coordination of behavioral health care, physical health care, social services, and other community resources.

## **Clinical Quality Measures**

CCBHCs are required to report on a series of clinical quality measures (CQMs) that reflect performance in key areas of integrated care. CQMs serve as standards for evaluating how well providers deliver care to individuals and populations.

#### **Planning Stage**

Define CQM focus and prepare to collect data

#### **Integration Stage**

Refine the process and scale or adapt as needed



#### **Execution Stage**

Collect CQMs and begin analyzing initial data

#### **Evaluation Stage**

Assess performance and identify what's working

### **Outcomes and Performance**
